Kentucky 4-H Achievement Eligibility Requirements

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be active, enrolled 4-H members in good standing within their county and have participated in 4-H in Kentucky for at least one year.
- Applicants must have at least 6-hours of 4-H involvement within their county 4-H program for the year they are applying.
- Applicants must meet the age requirements for the Achievement level they are applying for.
- Youth who have turned 19 but were active, enrolled 4-H members in the previous program year are eligible to apply.
- All information in the application must be accurate and truthfully represent the 4-H member's involvement and experiences. If the application is found to be falsified, it will be disqualified.
